

 Boy named Will to have & to hold the said Negro Boy unto the said Robochah
 Birchhead her heirs or Assigns to her own proper use & behoofe forever
 Without any manner of Challenge Claim or Demand from me the said
 Abraham Birchhead or from any other Person or Persons whatsoever
 for me or Authorized or Procured by me without any money or other
 Thing to be paid the said Robochah Birchhead my
 heirs & Assigns & the said Abraham Birchhead the said Negro Boy to
 the said Robochah Birchhead her heirs & Assigns to the use & against
 all People do & will warrant & for ever Defend by these Presents In
 Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Affixed my Seal
 this fiftenth Day of March Anno Domini 1734.
