

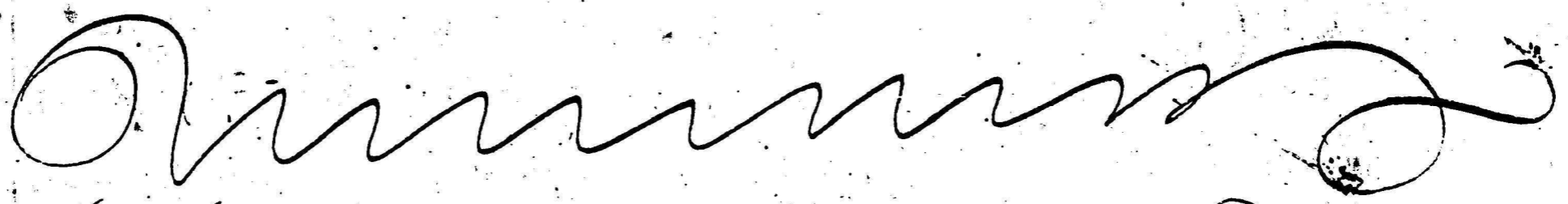
Memorandum that on the thirtieth Day of May in the Year

Prince Georges County Widows of the one part & Charles Carroll Esq.
of the City of Annapolis in An Arundell County of the other part
Witnesses that thos: Joyce Bradford for consideration of the sum
of Fifty four Pounds Sterling to her in hand paid the receipt
Whereof she Doth hereby Acknowledge & thereof Doth acquit the
said Charles, hath granted sold & confirmed as by these Presents
she doth bargain sell, Grant & confirm unto him thos: Charles
Carroll & his heirs all the two Parcels of Land herein mentioned
viz: the one called Plain Dealing Lying in Prince Georges
County containing five hundred Acres the other being two
(hundred)
