 substitute one or more attorneys under them with like or limited power
 and the same again to revoke and I do hereby promise to stand to and
 hold for good and valid all and whatsoever my said attorneys jointly
 or severally or their substitutes shall lawfully do or cause to be done
 in or about the promises by virtue of these presents *In Witness*
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal the twenty sixth day
 of March in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & thirty five
