Solomon Woodson for in Consideration of the Sum of twenty Pounds Ster. Bills of Exchange twenty Pounds Paper Currency of this Province and Ten Pounds Silver or Gold Currency of said Province by him the said John Wilmoth to him the sd. Solomon Woodson in hand paid the Receipt Whereof the sd. Solomon Woodson doth hereby acknowledge & doth by these Presents absolutely acquit & discharge the sd. John Wilmoth his heirs & assigns from the same & of from every Part & Parcel thereof Hath given Granted Bargained Sold & confirmed unto the sd. John Wilmoth his heirs & assigns for ever One certain Part or Parcel of Land lying in Baltimore County aforesaid now in the Tenure Tenure & Occupation of the sd. Solomon Beginning at a bounded Hickory standing on the West Side of a Stony Branch or Run known by the Name of Quins little Falls & running across the said branch or Run North about two Degrees East Sixty Perches unto another bounded Hickory standing by a small Draft of the afores. Branch or Run it being in the Given Line of the Tract of Land called Parrish's Range running thence up the Given Line of Parrish's Range North two Degrees East one hundred Sixty two Perches thence West Seventy Perches thence with a straight Line to the Beginning two containing & said out for Seventy Acres more or less And also one other Part of a Tract or Parcel of Land now in the Tenure & Occupation of my Brother John Woodson adjoining to the afo. Tract or Parcel of Land of Seventy Acres Beginning at a bounded White Oak & a bounded Gum standing where the
