of the Sum of three pounds current Money to him in hand paid by the said
Robert Woods at and before the Enrolling and Delivery of these presents
the Receipt whereof he the said Edward Stevenson doth hereby acknowledge
and that of and therefrom doth clearly acquit & discharge and Discharge
the said Robert Woods his heirs Executors and Assigns forever hath given
granted bargained sold aliened Enjoined & confirmed and by these
presents doth give grant bargain sell alien Enjoin & confirm unto the
said Robert Woods his heirs & Assigns forever a parcel of Land lying
in Baltimore County lying on the West Side of Bonsons fells called by the
name of Edward & Wiles Callops & liles and part of the enlargement it
being part of both the before named parcels of Land Beginning at a
bounded lile of Charles Moryman and Stone pasture standing on the east
Side of Bonsons fells & by the fells Side under a steep hill reaching over
the fells north west sixty perches to a bounded Gum on the Side of a
Hill then south west by west forty eight perches to a bounded white
