 Sums of money Goods wares, Merchandizes Effects  
 Estate and Things whatsoever which they the said person  
 and persons now do or shall hereafter owe and stand  
 Indebted or have in their or any of their hands Custody  
 or possession due Owing Belonging or in any wise  
 appertaining unto the Estates of the said Hugh Arbuthnot  
 Deceased or to them the said Constitutants as
