Choptank River in Baltimore County called & known by the Name of
Hills Forrest & containing a thousand Acres more or less, two other Tracts
or parcels of Land situate lying & being on the North Side of Little
Choptank River in Dorchester County the one called Touch's Hope
containing two hundred Acres, the other called Ragged Point containing
four hundred & forty Acres or thereabouts both the same more or less
To have & to hold the said several Parcels of Land called Hills Forrest
Touch's Hope & Ragged Point with all & singular the Premises, &
Rights, Profits, Advantages Enslavments & Appurtenances to the same belonging
or in any wise Appertaining unto him the said Joseph Hill, his heirs & Assigns
for ever, To his & their only proper use & behoof for ever more,
