This Indenture made the Twentieth day of June
A.D. 1732 between Jacob Isack and Charles Ridgley of Baltimore County Gentlemen
of the One part and Charles Carroll of the City of Annapolis
Surgeon of the Other part. Whereas John Isack late of Bal-
timore County Genl. Father of the said Gilbert Isack Isack
by his Last will and Testament in writing duly executed
and proved gave and devised unto the said Gilbert Isack
Isack, John Leon Isack and Robert Isack his three
Sons severall parcels of Land in the same Will Mencord
Lying in Baltimore County and containing seven hundred
and fifty four acres to be Equally divided amongst them
whosoever of them should arrive at the Age of Twenty
One years as by the same Will remaining on Record in
the Commissarys Office may appear and Whereas the said
Gilbert Isack Isack on the Twelfth day of October last
agreed to sell and Convey all the right land title by the said
Will of him the said Gilbert Isack of in and to the Land
aforesaid unto the said Charles Ridgley in Fee Simple
but Executed no Conveyance for the same Not this
Indenture witnesseth that the said Gilbert Isack
Isack with the approbation and Consent of him
the said Charles Ridgley Testified by the said Charles
his being party to these presents for in Consideration
of the severall sums of thirty pounds Current Money of
Maryland to the said Charles Ridgley in hand paid and five
Shillings like money to the said Gilbert Isack Isack by
the said Charles Carroll in hand paid before the Enscaling and
Delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they hereby
acknowledge and themselves therewith to be fully satisfied
Contented and paid for Bargained and sold and by these
presents.
