Shipped by the Grace of God in good Order and well Conditioned by William Hammond in and upon the Good Shipp called the Porporous Galley whereof is Master under God for this present Voyage Peter Brock and now Riding at anchor in the River of Matasco and by Gods Grace bound for London to say One Tish of Maryland Lead to be delivered in the like manner as in the margin and here to be delivered in the like good Order and well Conditioned at the R. Spott of London (the Danger of the seas only excepted) unto Mr. William Hunt or to his assigns he or they paying Freight for the said Goods seven pounds sterl. for Toward Maryland Duties with 1/2 Primage and Average accustomed in witness whereof the Master or purser of the said ship have affixed to Two Bills of Lading - all of this Tenour & Date the One of which two Bills being accomplished the Other One to stand void and so God sending Good ship to her desired port in safety Amen. Dated in Maryland Sep. 13. 1731 -
