Therefore that we Trusting in the Ability Care and Integrity of you
our said Councellour Have constituted and Ordained and by this our
Commission Do constitute and appoint you our said Councellour to be our
Judge or Commissary General for Probate of Wills and Granting of
Administrations within the whole Province of Maryland aforesaid.
