 & Assignes & every of them for ever Have given granted bargained  
 sold assigned aliened infeoffed transferred & confirmed And by these  
 presents do give grant bargain sell assign alien infeoff transfer &  
 confirm unto the said Elizabeth Coyle her Heirs & Assignes for ever All  
 that piece or parcel of Land (containing four hundred & thirty  
 Acres) which James Carroll late of Ann Arundell County aforesaid  
 Deceased did by his last Will & Testament bequeath unto the said
