& Granted & by these presents do give Grant a sign & Settle
to my Daughter Virlanda Taylor One Negro Girl now of the
Age of Seventeen Years or thereabouts called Kate and to my
Daughter Priscilla Taylor one other Negro Girl called Boty
aged thirtoen Years To have & to hold the same Negro
Girls called as aforesaid Kate & Boty unto my said Daughters
