shall bear) to have & to hold the said Negro Woman (her future Increase /
Except as before Excepted) unto her the said Mary Winitree her Heirs &
Executors Administrators and Assignors for the several uses Intents &
Purposes following that is to say the said Negro woman to be the Right &
Property of the said Mary Winitree her Heirs & Assignors at her age of
Sixteen years Day of Marriage or Day of my Death which shall first
happen & in case she shall happen to dye before she attains to her age of Sixteen
Day of Marriage or Day of my Death then the said Negro to be the Right &
Property of Jacob Andrew Winitree his Heirs & Assignors at the
age of Twenty one years or Day of my Death which shall first happen
in case of his Death before he attains his said age of Twenty one years or the
Day of my Death then to be the right & Property of Elizabeth Winitree her
heirs Executors & Assignors at the age of sixteen years Day of her marriage
or Day of my Death which shall first happen & in case of her Death before
the said age of sixteen years Day of her marriage or Day of my Death
the said Negro woman to be the sole Right & Property of me the said Jacob
Andrew Winitree my heirs & Assignors forever & to & for no other
