

for himself his heirs &c<sup>es</sup> & exec<sup>utors</sup> unto the said Benedict Bourdillon his heirs & assigns forever all that Tract or Parcalle of Land being one Moiety of a tract of Land called Bond's Pleasant Hills containing two hundred acres lying in Baltimore County on the East side of Gwin's Run; the said Moiety beginning at the first Bounded Tree of the said Tract called Bond's Pleasant Hills running thence South twenty seven Degrees West Sixty Porches thence North West Sixty Porches thence South Seventy Two Degrees & thirty Minutes West Seventy Porches to the end of the North fifteen Degrees & thirty Minutes West One hundred & forty Porches line of the Original Survey then reversing the said line North fifteen Degrees & thirty Minutes East one hundred & forty Porches then East one hundred Porches, then to the first tree containing One hundred acres of Land more or less to have & to hold the said Tract of Land together with all & singular the Rights Profits Benefits Priviledges Appertaininge unto him the said Benedict Bourdillon his heirs & assigns for ever free from & clear of all Manner of Incumbrances whatsoever (the Rents & Services that shall become due hereafter to the Lord Prop<sup>r</sup> only excepted) And he the said Peter Johnson for himself his heirs & Administrators doth covenant Promisegant & agreed to with the said Benedict Bourdillon his heirs & assigns that he shall & will for ever warrant & defend the said Tract or Parcalle of Land & all other the bargained Promises from all manner of Incumbrances whatsoever as also against all manner of Persons whatsoever claiming or to claim any Right Title or Interest therunto at his or their proper Charge to the said Benedict Bourdillon his heirs
