This Indenture made the Twelfth day of December in the
 year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and thirty seven —
 Between Elizabeth Cockey widow & Heir of Thomas Cockey late of
 Anne Arundel County deceased of the one part and Robert Boone of
 the said County Planter of the other part Whereas the said Elizabeth
 Cockey is now and stands justly intitled to one third part & share
 of all the Goods Chattels Rights Credits and other personall Estate
 of what nature and kind soever for Belonging to her said late husband
 deceased and whereas by one Deed pole bearing equal date with this
 presents the said Elizabeth Cockey hath fully authorized and appointed
 the said Robert Boone her true and Lawful attorney for & in her
 name and stead and for her use to have received and recover of and
 from the Executor or Executors of her said late husband deceased
 all her said share and part of her said husbands personall Estate
 as by the said Deed pole referred being thereunto had may more
 fully and at large it appears Now this Indenture Witnesseth
 that the said Elizabeth Cockey as well for and in Consideration
 of the Sum of five Shillings of Lawful money of Maryland to
 the said Elizabeth Cockey well and truly paid by the said Robert
 (Boone)
