-dred and forty Between Benjamin Lee of Calvert County  
in the province of Maryland planter of the one part and  
George Howard of the same County and province of the other  
part Witnesseth that Whereas a certain William Harris  
formerly of the County and province aforesaid Deced<sup>d</sup> in his life  
time was seized and possessed of a Tract of Land lying in  
Baltimore County Called Friendship containing Six Hundred  
Acres More or less As by his Last wills the said property grand  
or patent for the same remaining on Record in his Lordships  
land office at the City of Annapolis May appear Duly by his  
last Will and Testament in writing Duly proved Give and  
bequeath unto his Daughter Eliza Harris (Now the wife of  
a certain John Dorrumple and Mother to the above nam-  
-ed Benjamin Lee) Two Hundred Acres of Land being  
the remaining part of the aforesaid Tract of Six Hundred Acres
