This Indenture made the Twenty second Day of April in the year of Our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Forty One Between George Attwood of Prince Georges County in the Province of Maryland Gentleman of the one Part and Andrew Scott of Prince Georges County aforesaid the said Province Esquire of the other Part Witnesseth that the said George Attwood for and in Consideration of the sum of Fifty five Pounds Sterling Money to Him the said George Attwood in Hand paid at or before the Enrolling and Delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof the said George Attwood doth hereby Acknowledge and Him the said Andrew Scott of every part and Parcel thereof doth hereby acquit and Discharge He the said George xxx Attwood Hath Granted Bargained Sold Alienated Released and Confirmed and by these presents Doth Grant Bargain Sell Alien Release and Confirm unto the said Andrew Scott His Heirs and Assignes forever All that Share or Part of a Tract of Land called Friendship taken up between the late Colonel Thomas Addison and a certain William Hutchinson deceased containing Four Hundred and Twenty five Acres more or less lying
