-tember Anno Domini one thousand Seven Hundred and forty one Between  
Captain Philip Jones of Ann Arundell County of the one Part and  
Alexander Lawson of Baltimore County Gentleman of the other Part  
Whereas the Right Honourable Charles Absolute Lord and Propri-  
-etary of the Provinces of Maryland & Avalon Lord Baron of Bal-  
-timore &c: by his Letters Patent under the Great Seal of the said  
Province of Maryland bearing Date the Second Day of August in  
the twenty third Year of his Dominion over the said Province Annoq<sup>ue</sup>-  
Domini Seventeen Hundred & thirty Seven (for the Considerations  
therein mentioned) Did therefore thereby Grant unto him the said  
Philip Jones All that Tract or Parcel of Land called Bread and  
Cheese Mill lying & being in Baltimore County between the  
the Head of Bear Creek and a ~~small~~ Branch called Bread  
& Cheese Branch and joining to both Beginning at a bounded  
White Oak standing just by the said Bread & Cheese Branch on  
the South Side the same Opposite where the Tide commonly
