said John Tailor sign seal & Deliver the within Power
of Attorney for the uses therein mentioned.

hundred and forty one Between Abraham Hull of New Georges County
in the province of Maryland planter and Mark Bigler of the said
County and province planter of the other part Witnesseth that the said
Abraham Hull for and in consideration of the sum of sixty five pounds
current money of Maryland to him paid by the said Mark Bigler before
the sealing and Delivery of these presents the receipt Whereof he doth
herby acknowledge and thereof doth acquit exonerate and Discharge
the said Mark Bigler his heirs and assigns forever by these presents
doth give grant bargain sell alien release except and confirm and
by these presents doth give grant bargain sell and confirmed unto
