And in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and forty *BETWEEN* William Black of London Merchant and Hannah his wife of the one part and Richard Williams of Patuxent River in Prince Georges County in the province of Maryland Merchant of the other part *Witnesseth* that for and in Consideration of the sum of five shillings of Lawful money of Great Britain to the said William Black and Hannah his wife in hand paid by the said Richard Williams at and before the sealing and Delivery of these presents The Receipt whereof is here by acknowledged They the said William Black and Hannah his wife have and each of them hath bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them doth bargain and sell unto the said Richard Williams his Executors
