This Indenture made the eighteenth Day of March one thousand seven
hundred forty one Between Capt. Thomas Cresap of Prince George County
in the Province of Maryland of the one part and Jacob Mires of Lancaster
County and Province of Pennsylvania of the other part Witnesseth that
the said Tho: Cresap for and in Consideration of two hundred Pounds
Current Money of America to him in Hand paid by the said Jacob Mires
before the executing of these presents hath granted bargained and sold
unto the said Jacob Mires two Tracts of Land situate and lying in Balto-
more County the one Tract is part of Bonds Manor containing one
hundred forty five Acres being conveyed to the said Thomas Cresap
by Tho: Bond as will more at large appear by his Deed of Sale the
eighth Day of August 1739 the other Tract is called the Isles of Brames
Beginning at a bounded Suckamore Tree standing on a small Island
about four Perches to the westward from the aforesaid three Islands
thence South twenty Degrees East one hundred & sixty perches
North Seventy degrees East Forty perches North Twenty degrees
West one hundred & fifty perches North Seventy degrees East thirty
perches South twenty degrees East one hundred & fifty perches
North Seventy degrees East thirty perches South twenty degrees East one
hundred fifty three perches and a half North Seventy degrees East
thirty perches North twenty degrees West one hundred sixty three
perches and a half Thence bearing back to the place of Begin-
ning containin one hundred Acres more or less To Have
And to hold the said two tracts of Land above mentioned with
there appurtenances unto the said Jacob Mires his Heirs and
Assigns for Ever and to no other Use Intent or Purpose what
soever
