Ann Arundell ^{in the Province of Maryland} County Gentleman of the other Part Witnesseth
that the said John Tailor for and in Consideration of the Sum
of lighty five pounds & four Shillings Sterling to him in hand
paid by the said John Gaspaway the Receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged & the said John Gaspaway thereof & thereupon
fully acquitted and Discharged hath Bargained sold made
over and Confirmed and by these presents Doth Bargain
sell make over & Confirm unto the said John Gaspaway All
that Parcel of Land being Part of a Tract of Land called
Marys Mount lying and being in the County and Province
afo^r Beginning at a Cherry Tree standing at the South West
Corner of John Woodens Land & running thence North two
Degrees West One hundred & fifty nine Perches then West and
by North fifty nine Perches then South Ten Degrees West One
hundred and sixty perches to a four Notched Oak then South
West thirty five perches and from thence by a Straight line
