or recorded and shall duly & carefully look after sustain pre-
serve repair & maintain all the severall books papers & records
now being & remaining in the said Office as also all those
that from time to time during his Continuance in the said
Office shall be added therunto in such manner as that in Case of
Death or that he shall be legally Dismissed from Officiating
longer in the said Office the said Edm. Jennings his Exors or
Adms shall Surrender & Deliver up or cause to be surrendered &
Delivered up to the next Person who shall succeed him in
the s^d. Provincial Court Office all the Papers & Record Books now
being in the s^d. Provincial Court Office in good Order & repair as
also all such other Papers & Record Books which shall be by
him added in like good order & repair with the Records & Entries
faithfully legally & truly made up & Entered during the time
he hath officiated in the said Provincial Court Office without
favour or Affection but according to the truth the Nature of
the thing & the Duty of his Office and all other the Dutys of
his s^d. Office legally duly & faithfully shall Discharge accord-
ing to Law and the true Intent and Meaning of the Act of
Assembly in such Cases made & provided That this the above
Obligation to be void and of none Effect or else to be & remain
in full force and Virtue in Law
