John Prop of the same place Esq. and John Steburn of Prince Georges County Esq. are held and firmly bound unto the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary of this Province of Maryland in the full and just sum of one thousand Pounds Currency to be paid to the said Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary and his Successors to which Payment well and truly to be made We and every of us <sup>proby</sup> bind ourselves and every of us our and every of our Heirs Executors Admors and assigns jointly and severally firmly by these Presents sealed with our Seals and dated this ninth Day of March 1742/3

The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bounden Edmund Jennings while he shall continue in the Office of Secretary of Maryland shall at his own proper Cost and Charge find a supply of good and sufficient
