as that in case of Death or that he shall be Legally Dismissed from officiating
longer in the said Office, he the said Lewis Gale his Executors or Administrators
shall Surrender and Deliver up or cause to be Surrendered and Delivered
up to the next person who shall succeed him in the said Land office, all
the papers and Record Books now being in the said Land Office, in good
order and Repair as also all ^{other} such papers and Record Books which shall
be by him added in like good order and Repair with the Records and entries
faithfully Legally and truly made up and entered During the time he hath officiated
in the said Office without favour or affection but according to the truth the nature
of the Thing and the Duty of his office and all other the Duties of his said Office
legally duly and faithfully shall Discharge according to Law and the true
Intent and meaning of the Act of Assembly in such cases made and Provided
That then the above Obligation to be void and of none Effect or effects to be and remain
in full force and Virtue in Law.
