This Indenture made the second Day of September in the Year of our Lord God One thousand Seven hundred forty & three Between George Sheymar of Goodland County in the Colony of Virginia But heretofore of Baltimore County in the Province of Maryland on the one part & Charles Carroll of the City of Annapolis on the other part Witnesseth that the said George Sheymar for & in Consideration of the Sum of Fifteen pounds Sterling Money of Great Britain to him in hand paid by the said Charles Carroll at & before the sealing & Delivery of these Presents the Receipt whereof he Doth hereby acknowledge & thereof & of every part & parcel thereof doth acquit & release him the said Charles Carroll his Exors Admors & Assigns that given granted Bargained sold aliened lifeoffed & confirmed & by these Presents doth absolutely & freely give grant bargain sell alien lifeoffe & confirm unto him the said Charles Carroll his Heirs & Assigns for ever all that Tract or parcel of Land called Sheymars Adversitars Situate lying & being in Baltimore County afo<sup>re</sup> granted unto him the said George Sheymar the Tenth Day of August One thousand Seven hundred & eighteen for One hundred Acres of Land together with all & singular the Woods Underwoods Buildings Orchards Taming & other Appurtenances Profitts & Advantages in upon or to the said Tract of Land any ways belonging & appertaining To have and To hold unto him the said Charles Carroll his Heirs & Assigns for ever the said tract of Land called Sheymars Adversitars
