This Indenture made the Eighth Day of February in the Year
of our Lord God Seventeen hundred and forty three Between Samuel
Howard of An Arundell County in the Province of Maryland Planter
Eldest Son and heir at Law to Samuel Howard late of the said County
Planter Deceased of the one part, and John Brice of the County and
Province afo^r gent^r of the other Part, Whereas the afo^r Samuel
Howard by his certain Indenture bearing Date the tenth Day of
September last past did for the Consideration of Two hundred eighty
and three pounds current money to him in hand paid by the said John
Brice before the sealing and Delivery of the afo^r Indenture give
Grant Bargain Sell Alien Enforce and Confirm unto him the said
