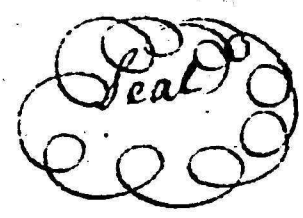

and Ability of Jonas Green Gent^r to execute the Office

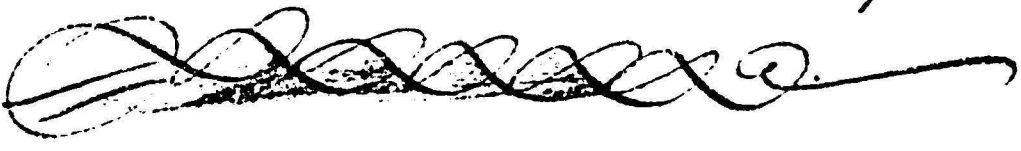
and Duties required of a Deputy Post Master, and having

my lawfull and sufficient Deputy, to execute the office of
Deputy Postmaster of Annapolis in the Province of Maryland

to the same belonging; for so long as I shall Judge it for his Majesty's
Service to continue him therein; and under such Conditions Covenants
Provisos, payments orders and Instructions to be faithfully ob-
performed and done, by the said Deputy, and servants, as he or
they shall, from time to time receive from me
