This Indenture made this tenth Day of February Anno Domini Seventeen Hundred and forty seven Between Nathaniel of Kent County and Province of Maryland planter of the one part and Samuel Droom of the same County & Province Gentleman of the other part Witnesseth, that the same Nathaniel for and in Consideration of five Shillings Current Money of Maryland to him the same Nathaniel by the same Samuel in Hand paid before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the Receipt whereof the same Nathaniel doth hereby acknowledge and for diverse other good Causes and Considerations him the same Nathaniel hereunto moving hath granted, bargained & sold and by these presents doth Grant, Bargain and sell unto the same Samuel his Heirs and Assigns All that part or parcel of Land lying and being in Kent County aforesaid called The Exchange and commonly known and reputed to be part of a part of Land called Cornwells's Choice, Beginning, at a bearing thence north and standing by the side of a Little Cove and running from the said Cove East Cross the said Cove and into the Woods one Hundred and twenty paces, bounding on the East of the said East Line and running along North until it intersect a West Line of a parcel of Land formerly in the possession of a certain Robert Gibson one Hundred & Eighteen paces, Bounded on the said Intersection, and running along West along the Land of the said Gibson and until it intersect a South, South East Line of the Land of a certain William Walter Bounding on the said Intersection and running South, South East along the Land of the said Walter and into the first Bounded Cove containing one Hundred Acres of Land more or less Together with all & singular the Appurtenances hereunto belonging To HAVE AND TO HOLD, the said part or parcel of Land and Appurtenances contained within the Lines and Bounds aforesaid unto the same Samuel his Heirs and Assigns from the last Day of December last past before the Date of these presents for and during and unto the full End and Term of one whole Year from thence next ensuing and fully to be Computed & Ended Yielding and paying, therefore the Rent of one penny Current Money of Maryland at the End of the said Term if the same shall be then Lawfully Demanded So the intent that by Virtue of these presents and by force of the Statute for transferring of Uses into possession made and provided, the said Samuel may be in the actual possession of the said part or parcel of Land and premises and may be thereby Enabled to take a Grant and Release of the Inheritance thereof to him and his Heirs for Ever to and for the Uses, Intents and purposes intended to be Limited and Declared in certain Indentures of Release and Confirmation intended to be made the Day next after the Date of these presents and to be made (Between)
