the same County Joiner on the other part Witnesseth that the said Edward  
Owens for and in Consideration of the Sum of four Thousand Pounds of  
Tobacco to him in hand paid by the said Robert Langford the Receipt  
whereof the said Edward Owens doth hereby Acknowledge and himself  
therewith to be fully Satisfied Content and Paid Hath Given Granted  
Bargained Sold Aliened Released and Confirmed and by these Presents  
doth Give Grant Bargain Sell Alien Release and Confirm unto him the  
said Robert Langford his Heirs and Assignes for ever all that Tract or  
Parcell of Land called and known by the Name of Shady Grove containing  
fifty Acres taken up by William Bradshaw Situate lying and being in  
Prince Georges County Beginning at three Bounded Chesnut  
Saplines standing at the Head of the Northernmost Head of Hawlings
