

Maryland vs. R. Coagl by these presents that I Patrick —  
Coagl of the City of Annapolis in the Province aforesaid Merchant  
for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and thirty five  
Pounds first money of the said Province by John Bullen of the  
same place Merchant to me in hand paid or secured to be paid  
Hath bargained and sold and by these presents do (in plain copies  
markt) bargain and sell unto the said John Bullen a certain —  
Schooner called the Elizabeth being a round Stern Vessel of the burthen  
of about Twenty Tons built at New England in the Year Seventeen  
hundred and Twenty Nine and by her then Register called the Mary  
which Register was cancelled and the said Schooner by Decree of the —  
Court of Vice Admiralty of the said Province the fourth Day of No-  
vember Seventeen hundred and thirty four condemned as forfeited to the  
use of his majesty his Excellency Samuel Ogle Esq; Governor of said  
Province and Benjamin Tasker Esq; Surveyor of the Port of Annapolis  
for breach of the Acts of Trade and Navigation and by them sold to —  
me the said Patrick and a new Register granted bearing Date —  
the fourth Day of February Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and  
thirty four as per said last mentioned Register reference being —  
that he had well more fully and large appear to have and to hold  
the said Schooner together with all her tackle apparel & furniture  
as also the said last mentioned Register witnesseth the said John —  
Bullen his heirs and assigns for ever & no other intent or  
purpose whatsoever and the said Patrick for himself his Heirs —  
 Executors & Crouns doth covenant promise grant and Agreeth and  
with the said John Bullen & his Assigns the aforesaid Schooner with all  
the aforesaid Appurts to her belonging from and against him the said  
Patrick and all persons claiming under him by those presents for  
ever hereafter to the said John Bullen and his Assigns will warrant  
and defend in witness whereof the said Patrick Coagl hath here-  
unto set my hand and Seal this twentieth Day of September in  
the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and Ninety eight
