Cables Ropes Cord Gun & other Instruments Artillery Boats Cars Ladders  
Stores & provision Rigging Tackles Apparel furniture & Appurtenances  
whatsoever to the said Brigantine belonging or in anywise appertaining  
To have & to hold all the said Brigantine or Schooll & all other  
the promises whatsoever hereby Bargained & sold w<sup>th</sup> the Appurtenances  
unto the said John Bullon & W<sup>m</sup> Simbrill & either of them their & Adm<sup>rs</sup>  
& Assigns to their & either of their use & uses Benefits & behoof  
as their & either of their own proper Goods & Chattels for ever and the
