sell & transfer make Over unto the said W<sup>m</sup> Murray One third part of the  
within mentioned Brigantine or Vessel called the St Andrew together w<sup>th</sup> one  
third part of all her Sackles Apparel & furniture to her as within mentioned  
belonging To have & to hold the said one third part of the said Brigantine  
together w<sup>th</sup> one third part of the Appurtenances Above mentioned  
belonging to him the said William Murray his heirs & assigns for ever  
& to no other use Intent or purpose whatsoever In Witness  
Whereof we have hereunto set our hands & Seals this Seventh Day  
of November in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred &  
thirty eight.
