


the Peace for the said County and acknowledged the within Deed according to the
Directions of the Act of Assembly in such Cases (provided and Ann Broad the
Wife of the said Thomas Broad being by us Examined a part from her said
Husband declared that she voluntarily relinquished all her Right of Dower
to the within Bargained Premises & that she was not induced so to do by
Coercion of her said Husband or for fear of his Displeasure.

he the said Henry Morgan shall think proper & be advised to do & do all
other Acts and things requisite and necessary in & about the premises and
