This Indenture made the eighteenth Day of
October in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred
and forty five Between Nicholas Vaneman of Prince
Georges County in the Province of Maryland Yeoman
of the one part and Hugh Parker of the City of Philadel-
phia in the Province of Pennsylvania of the other part
Witnesseth that for the consideration of the Sum of one hundred
Pounds Current money of the Province of Pennsylvania by
him the Said Hugh Parker to the Said Nicholas Vaneman
well and truly paid before the Sealing and Delivery of these
presents the receipt whereof he the Said Nicholas Vaneman
Doth hereby acknowledge and from the same and every part
thereof Exonerate Acquit and Discharge the Said Hugh Parker
his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns All^l given
granted bargained and Sold Aliened Transferred and made
over and by these presents Doth give grant bargain Sell
Alien transfer and make over unto the Said Hugh Parker
his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns for ever
all that Tract or parcell of Land called Vanemans Strigle
containing one hundred Acres lying and being in Prince Georges
County as by the Patent thereof to the Said Nicholas
Vaneman Dated the twelfth Day of December Seven ten
hundred and thirty nine appears together with all rights
profits benefits privileges & appurtenances to the same
belonging or in any wise appertaining (Royal mines excepted)
