

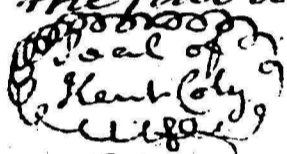

Consideration of the Sum of Sixty Six pounds Current  
Money of Maryland to him in hand paid by the s<sup>r</sup>.  
Charles Carroll the Receipt of which he doth hereby  
Acknowledge hath given granted Bargained Sold  
Aliened Infeoffed and Confirmed Unto him the s<sup>r</sup>.
