 parcell of plantable Land with the appurtenances
 hereunto belonging being the moiety or half part of a
 Tract of Land called the Grove that is to say all that
 part of the said Tract heretofore by Deed of bargain
 Sale enrolled bearing Date the twenty third day
 of June Anno Domini Sixteen hundred eighty five granted
 and sold by Cornelius Comegys and Mary his wife
 to Henry Staples and afterwards granted and sold by
 William Blay to a certain Wm Glanville Scituate and
 being on the East side of Chesapeake Bay in a river called
 Chester River and on a branch called the South East
