Day of September in the year of our Lord one Thousand Seven
Hundred and forty Six between John Emory Junr. of Quoon
Anns County Gentleman of the one part Mathew Bead
of the same County planter of the second part Thomas
Hynson Wright of the same County Gentleman of the
Third Part Whereas by and upon a Writ of entry upon
Disseisin in the post returnable before the Justices of the
Provincial Court the second Tuesday in September now past &
the said John Emory did Demand against the same Thomas
Hynson Wright all that neethermost Moiety or half part of
that Tract of Plantable Land lying and being in Quoon
Anns County a.s. commonly called Reading & afterwards
called now Reading lying to the Westward of a line drawn
from a bounded Red Oak standing at the Head of a Branch
called Deep Branch and running North Thirty one
(Degrees)
