This Indenture made this sixteenth day of
February in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred forty
and six 1746 George Stewart of the City of Annapolis
Gentleman of the one part and his Excellency Thomas Bladen
Esquire Governour of the Province of Maryland of the other
part Witnesseth that the said George Stewart for and in con-
sideration of the sum of five Shillings Sterling to him in
hand paid by the said Thomas Bladen Esquire before the
said Stewart bargained sold aliened enfeoffed confirmed and by
dealing and delivery of these presents doth grant bargain
sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said Thomas Bladen
Esquire his Heirs and Assigns forever all that tract or parcel
of Land lying in Baltimore County Originally on the fifteenth
day of August Sixteen hundred Ninety and Six granted unto
a certain Robert Case for the Quantity of five hundred Acres
who dying without Heirs the same became Escheat and
upon a Survey there of the said tract before mentioned called
Case's Forest was again Viz the fourth day of September in the
Year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred forty and six
granted unto him the said George Stewart by the name of Case's
Forest under the Meas and Bounds following lying and being
in Baltimore County on the North side Calapow river in
the Woods up Jones falls and in a fork of the said falls above
Captain Oulson Garrison Beginning at a Bounded White
Oak It being a Bounded Tree of William Cockey's standing
in the falls and being the South and West bounded tree of Cockey's
Land called Cockey's Forest and running up the South West
