



247 For the same and Acquittances or other Discharges for the same

In the Back of the foregoing Power of Attorney was written  
the following Assignment Viz

Maryland for Dorchester County Feby 23: 1746

I Wm all men by these presents that I John Hillbe of the Province  
and County aforesaid Merchant do Alein Assign and Deliver to Francis  
Lee of said Province Merchant all my Right Title <sup>Priority &</sup> Interest of  
and to my moiety of an Insurance made in company with the  
said Francis Lee by Messrs. John Chipol and Company of London  
Merchants on the Hull Rigging and Cargo &c. of the Snow  
Flying Fish for the sum of four hundred Pounds starting  
the said Vessel bying Bound from the Island Barbadoes in  
the West Indies to Maryland was taken in her Passage by a  
French Privateer one Policeer or Puluce Master or Comman-  
der of said Privateer and George M. Lester being Master of  
said Snow Flying Fish and thereby Acknowledge that I  
have full Right and Power to make over the said Insurance  
to said Francis Lee and that it is so fully received of him &  
thereby Impower the said Francis Lee to Recover and receive
