and that the said George Scott shall will & truly pay unto
the said Elizabeth the Daughter the said sum of four hundred
and Twenty pounds Sterling Money that therefrom thence
forth these presents shall cease and determine & also the Deed
of Bargain & Sale Executed by the said George Scott to the
said Richard Bennett shall also cease & determine & be void
to all Intents and purposes whatsoever and that the said
George Scott shall be and stand seized as of his former Estate
to him his Heirs and assigns forever of and in the said four
Hundred & Twenty eight Acres of Land with the appurtenances
as fully and amply as if the said Deed of Bargain & Sale
had never been Executed by the said George Scott anything in the
