Helms and Ann his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Ten
Pounds Current money of Maryland to them in hand paid by the said
Charles Carroll the Receipt whereof they do hereby Acknowledge and
thereof and therefrom do Acquit and Discharge him the said Charles
Carroll Hath given granted Bargained Sold Released and Con-
firmed unto him the said Charles Carroll his heirs and Assigns
(Forever)
