acquit release and Discharge him the said Charles
Carroll his Heirs Executors &c. I hath given granted Bar-
gained sold aliened linfoffed and confirmed by these Pre-
sents Deth his grant Bargain sell alien. linfoffed and
Confirmed to him the said Charles Carroll all the re-
mainning Part unsold to him the said Charles of a tract
of Land called Pistole Thicket originally granted unto Richd
Lemoyne of said Baltimore County the tenth Day of April
