This Indenture made this twenty eighth Day of February in the Year
of our Lord Christ one Thousand Seven hundred and forty and four Between
Ann Carr of Talbot County in the Province of Maryland Widow heretofore called
Ann King one of the Daughters and Devisees of John King late of the same
County deceased and Nathaniel Wright of the City of Philadelphia Mayor eldest
Son of Solomon Wright late of Queen Anns County in the Province afo. and
Elizabeth his Wife which said Elizabeth was another of the Daughters and Devisees
of the same John King of the one part, and Thomas Wilkinson of Queen Anns County
in the Province afo. Gentleman of the other part, Witnesseth that the same
Ann Carr and Nathaniel Wright for and in consideration of the sum of
five Shillings Current money of Maryland afo. to them in hand paid by the
afo. Thomas Wilkinson the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and for
divers other good Causes and Considerations them thereunto moving Have
Granted Bargained and Sold, and by these presents do and each of them
Doth grant Bargain and Sell unto the same Thomas Wilkinson
and his assigns all that Tract or Parcel of Land with the appurtenances
called Howards Gift lying Situate and being formerly in Cecil County
but now in Kent County in the Province afo. at the head of a Creek
called Farley Creek Beginning at a marked Coplar Tree Standing on the south
Side of a Branch called Coplar Branch being the Northernmost bound of
a Tract of Land taken up for Elias King and William Harris called by
the name of Coplar farm and running from the said Tree North North
West one hundred and fifty fethes, and from thence with a line Drawn
East North East three hundred and Twenty Berches and then with a
line drawn from the end of the East North East line South South East one
