up in Partnership or Company Joyntly Between the said Campbell
and Lawrence Robinson and now intending to divide the said Tract each
to have their Separate Share according to their several Shares as specified
by the Pattern Viz One hundred and Eighty Acres To the Moity of J^r
Campbell and one hundred and thirty to the Share of Lawrence Robinson
And Whereas a certain Branch or Water Run proceeding from a
Spring supplying the use of the Dwellinghouse of Ignatius
Diggles Quarter Intersuting the said Tract and running through
the said Tract and the said John Campbell Doth hereby Quit
Claim unto the said Lawrence Robinson all and every that
