day of April Anno Domini Seventen hundred and forty eight  
Between John Buck of Baltimore County Planter of the  
one part and James Walker of Annapondell County Surgeon  
of the other part Witnesseth that Whereas Charles the second  
Absolute Lord and Proprietor of the Province of Maryland by  
his Letters Patent under the Great Seal of the said Province  
did on the Twenty fifth day of April Seventen hundred and  
Seventen Grant unto John Buck of Baltimore County aforesaid  
Father of the aforesaid John Buck all that Tract or Parcel of  
Land called Bucks Lick lying and being then in  
Baltimore but now in Annapondell County on the South  
side of Patuxent River Beginning at a Bounded White Oak  
standing near a Glade called Cabin Glade and near the  
West North West Line of a Tract of Land called Andover  
containing and then laid out for Sixty nine Acres of Land  
more or less as by the said Patent now on Record in his  
Lordships Land Office Lib. B. L. No. 4 folio 246 May more
