 Witnesseth Whereas Charles Craycroft by Deed bearing date  
 the Twelfth day of July One Thousand Seven hundred and  
 thirty five and Recorded in Charles County Records the 5<sup>th</sup> day  
 of August 1735 Lib: S<sup>o</sup> 96 & 97 did Mortgage unto the  
 said Charles Carroll All those Two Tracts or Parcels of  
 Land in the said Deed described Viz<sup>t</sup> five hundred Acres of  
 Land being part of a Tract of Land called Trumans Place  
 Also all that Tract of Land called the Denial containing  
 one hundred Acres lying in Charles County Now this  
 Indenture Witnesseth That the s<sup>d</sup> Charles Craycroft  
 for and in consideration of the Sum of Three hundred &  
 Twenty Three Pounds Sterling to him in hand paid by the  
 s<sup>d</sup> Charles Carroll before the Consecaling and Delivery of  
 these Presents the Receipt whereof the doth hereby acknow-  
 ledge Doth hereby Promise Release and for ever Quit claim  
 of in and to those Two Tracts or Parcels of Land called Trumans  
 Place and Denial to him the s<sup>d</sup> Charles Carroll his Heirs  
 and assigns for ever To have and to hold the said Two  
 Tracts or Parcels of Land called Trumans Place and  
 Denial as af<sup>s</sup> with all and singular the Improvem<sup>ts</sup> Con-  
 veniences and Advantages to the said Two Tracts or Parcels  
 of Land called Trumans Place and Denial belonging or in  
 any wise appertaining unto him the said Charles Carroll  
 his Heirs and assigns for ever In Witness whereof the said  
 (Charles)
