the Eastern side of Chesapeake Bay called or known  
by the name of Thompsons Islands Being all the  
Island or Broken Lands or Hammocks of Wood Lands  
lying in the Marshes lying on the Eastern side of Chesa-  
peake Bay Between the Straits of the said Bay and  
Transquaking Bay and the middle Straits of the  
said Bays running by a Parcel of Islands called  
Hedgers Islands Excepting the Islands of Thomas Courtney
