Acknowledge and thereof do acquit and Discharge the
said William Thornton his Heirs Executors Admrs
and Assigns have Bargained Sold and Delivered and
by these Presents do Bargain, Sell and Deliver unto
the said William one Negro Woman called Parthena one
ditto called Hagar, one Negro Boy called Frank one ditto
called Sam. one ditto called Harry one Negro Girl called
Dinah with their Increase also part of a Tract or parcel
of Land called Birkhead's Place containing forty
Acres lying and being between Syon's Creek and Big
Point in said County, also sixteen head of Hogs
marked with an Upper Heel and an under Heel, six
Cows and two Yearlings marked as the Hogs, one Black
Horse, one new Cart two Feather Beds and Furniture
and all the Crop of Corn & Tobacco that is or shall be
on any of the Plantations of the said John with all my
Right Title Interest and Claim in and to the said
Mortgaged Premises, and I do hereby Covenant and agree
to and with the said William to Warrant and forever
Defend the said Mortgaged Premises to him his Heirs
Executors Admrs. and Assigns against all manner of
Person whatsoever Provided always and it is
the true Intent and meaning of these Presents that if
the above mentioned John Roberts his Heirs Executors
Admrs or Assigns do and shall at all times when
required full and faithfully comply with and truly
