the Receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge and thereof
and every part and Parcel thereof do fully clearly and
absolutely Acquit Exonerate and Discharge the said
Caleb Dorsey his Executors and Administrators by
these Presents and for divers other good Causes and
Considerations them thereunto moving they the said Richard
Ovinge and John Greenif Howard have granted Bargained
Sold aliened In feoffed and Confirmed and by these Presents
do grant Bargain Sell Enfeoff and Confirm unto the said
Caleb Dorsey and his Heirs all that Tract or Parcel
of Land called the Valley of Oving lying on the South side of
the Main Falls of Catapwoc River now in Ann Arundell
County but formerly in Baltimore County containing three
